- Communicates to Production Supervisor major issues that threaten the build schedule
- Monitors and maintains good housekeeping practices providing support by fixing and/or reporting deviations
- Upholds, adheres to and promotes Health and Safety policies and procedures reporting any unsafe acts to production supervisor(s)
- Reviews, monitors, motivates adherence to Bend All policies and procedures
